**Award categories:**

- (A) Best overall team. The team completing the highest number of laps.
- (B) Best Club team. Highest number of laps completed by a club team.  
(A club may enter more than one team).
- (C) Best team. Comprising riders in the team whose combined ages are greater than 220 years.
- (D) Best team. Best Sidecar Team comprising two outfits.

**Program for Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May racing:**

**Solo 100 Mile Team Race**

Each team to be made up of 4 riders, each riding a machine from one of the following classes:

- (A) Pre-65 up to 250cc Number plates - white numbers on black.
- (B) Pre-60 or Pre-unit Number plates - black numbers on white. **FRONT PLATE ONLY**
- (C) Pre-68 unit over 251cc Number plates – black numbers on yellow **COVER SIDE NUMBERS**
- (D) Pre-74 (1969 - 1974) Number plates – white numbers on red.

Each team must have 4 different machines – one from each of the above categories.

Each team shall carry the same riding number on each of its machines (riding number to be issued

Each rider must complete 2 blocks of 20 minutes starting with rider on machine from class (A), then (B), (C) & (D) consecutively for the first block.

**Sidecar Race** Teams of two machines each team to complete 2 x 15min blocks  
Approx 1hr +2 laps
